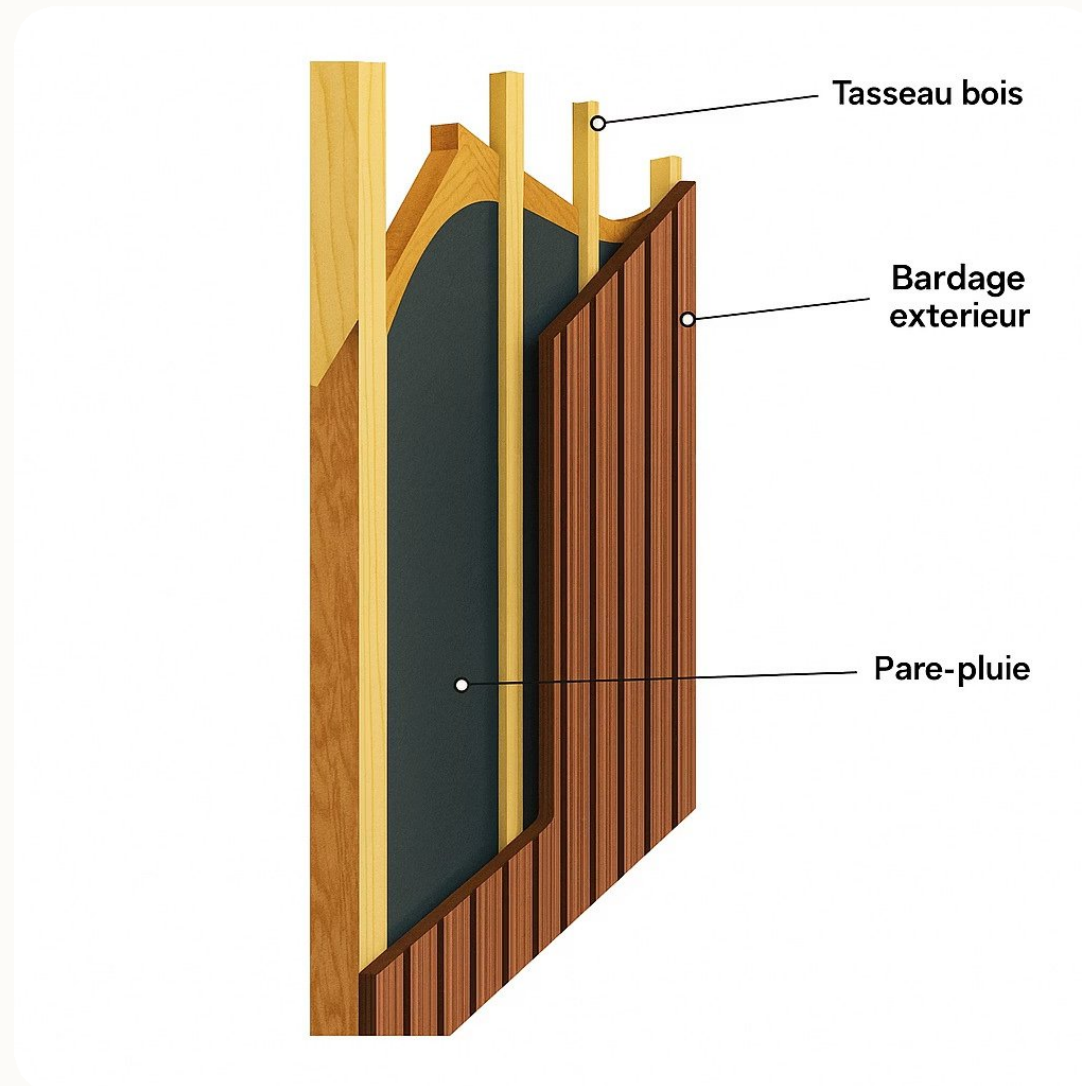

Exterior wall sections

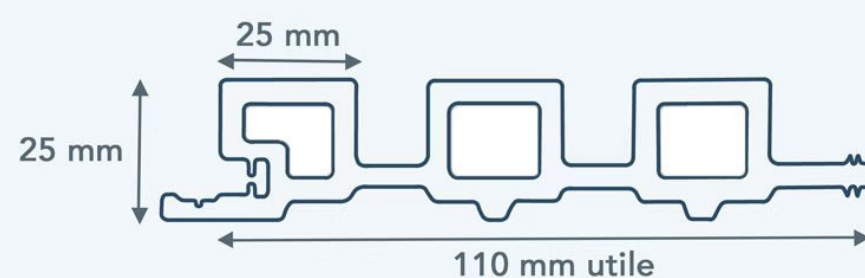

PVC cut

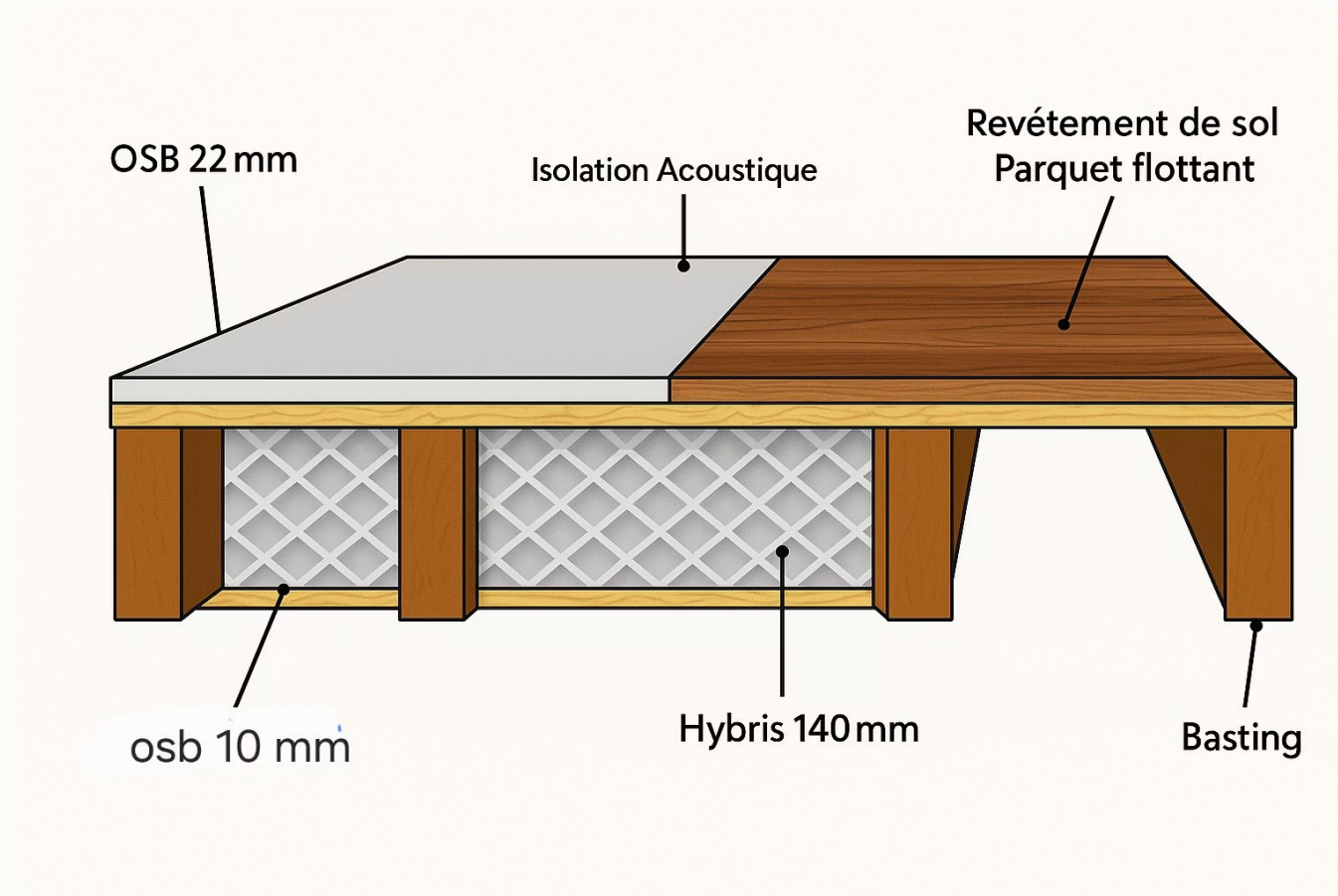

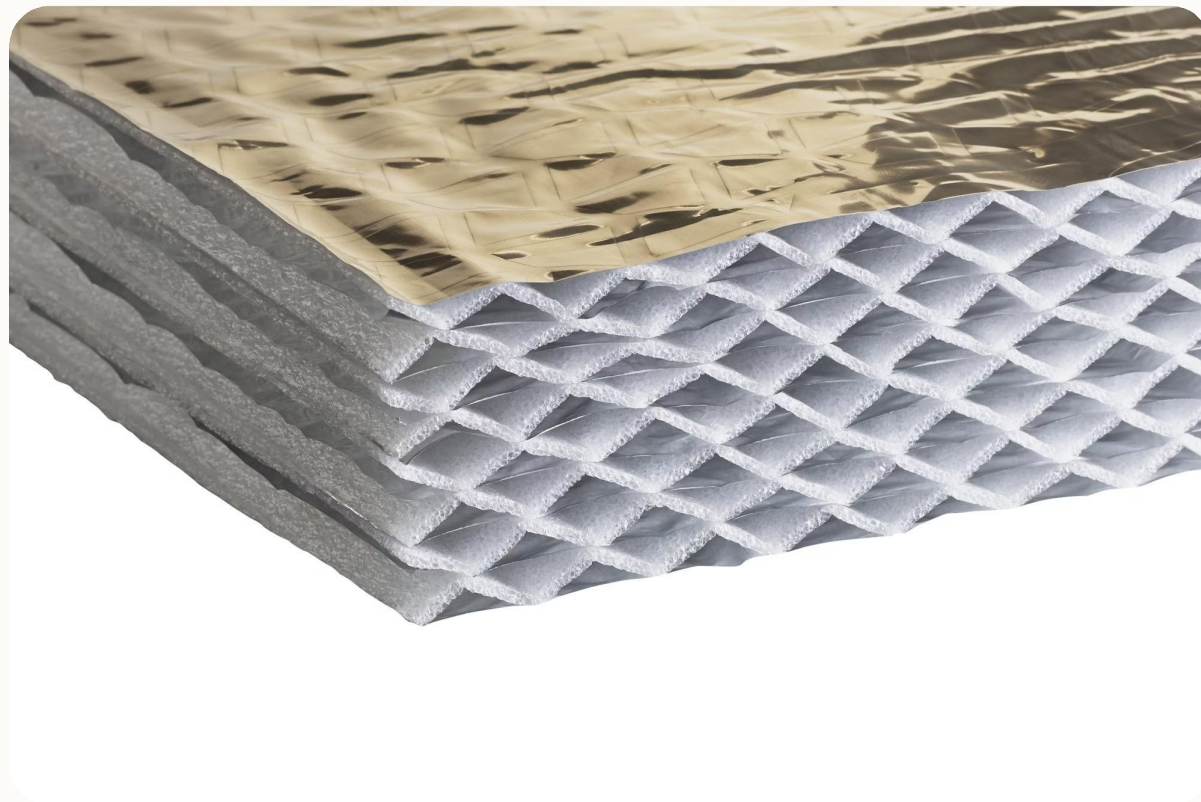
